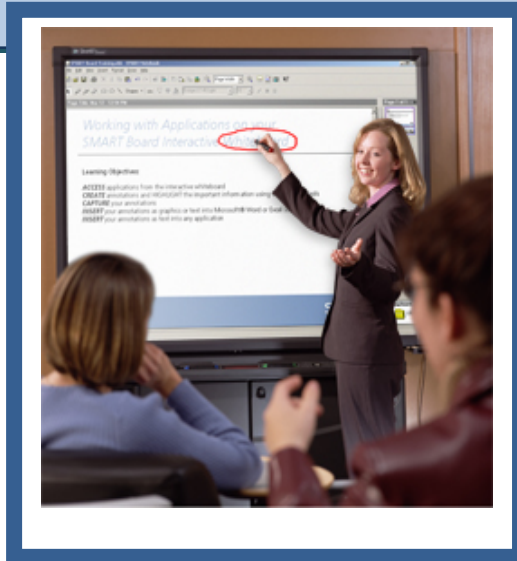


“SMART Boards for Administrators”
