Woodcock-Johnson IV Test of Achievement and Tests of Oral Language (September 14, 2015)

This workshop teaches administration, scoring, and interpretation of all of the tests of achievement, with emphasis on the new tests and the changes from the WJ III. All administration and scoring details will be reviewed, followed by modeling of the procedures on video, and an opportunity for participants to practice scoring. There will also be an emphasis on interpretation of the test results. Tests from the WJ IV Oral Language battery will also be reviewed, with emphasis on the tests most applicable to a learning disability assessment.

Woodcock-Johnson IV Test of Cognitive Abilities (September 15, 2015)

This workshop teaches administration, scoring, and interpretation of the tests of cognitive abilities, with emphasis on the new tests and the changes from the WJ III. All administration and scoring details will be reviewed, followed by modeling of the procedures on video, and an opportunity for participants to practice scoring. There will also be an emphasis on interpretation of the test results. Tests from WJ IV Oral Language Battery that could be used to assess cognitive and memory abilities will also be reviewed.
