Content: Building-level teams returning for Tier 1/Universal-Day 3 will revisit essential school-wide systems (data, teaching, acknowledgement, and interventions) and use the Team Implementation Checklist (TIC) to self-assess current implementation and action plan around identified needs. In addition, participants will look at the Benchmarks of Quality (BOQ) to begin to understand the use of the tool in self-evaluation.

Objectives:

1. Review of the Tier 1/Universal PBIS processes by working through the PBIS Team
2. Implementation Checklist and action planning on School-Based Unified Action Plan for each component
3. Plan implementation through development of systems, data and practice
4. Plan for stakeholder buy-in, implementation, and sustainability
5. Receive technical assistance from PBIS Network in developing and planning for implementation of school-wide systems.
