

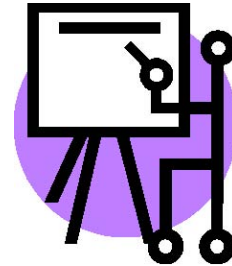
# Indicator #14 - Improving Employment Outcomes for Students with Disabilities
