Participants in this hands-on workshop will examine the learning environment for teachers and students made possible through the effective use of wikis. Wikis are a free and easy to use tool that can powerfully facilitate collaboration and communication. In this hands-on workshop, participants will set up their own wiki using PBWorks, add 'wow' features to their wiki, and will learn how wikis can be used in the classroom. Some of the 'wow' features that we will embed are: videos, graphics, gadgets, sounds, and more. Come see how wikis can increase the engagement of students, encourage collaboration, and enable students to build connections, stimulate, and facilitate discussion.

This workshop will enable you to create your own wiki and understand possible uses of wikis in education.

In this workshop you will:

- Create a PBWorks account to access the wiki site
- Receive guided, hands-on practice creating a wiki using PBWorks.
- Understand the features and be able to use a variety of tools and resources within PBWorks to develop a wiki.
- Explore a variety of items to embed into the wiki to add more content and excitement.

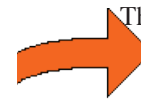
