



The SCERTS Model

This 2-day course will introduce the SCERTS model, a comprehensive, multidisciplinary educational approach designed for children with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD). This model is not exclusive of other treatment approaches and methodologies, but rather provides a framework for those who are seeking guidelines for implementing a comprehensive educational plan that is based on our knowledge of the core developmental challenges faced by children with ASD.

Participants will learn how to determine meaningful, purposeful, and motivating goals based on a child's developmental stage, functional needs, and family priorities.
