

## 1 or 2 graduate credits available

CESA 2 is offering a book study facilitated by Trisha Spende, Literacy Consultant and Karen Russell, Early Childhood Program Support Teacher. The focus is on Literacy Skills and Strategies that support these developmental skills within your classroom and work with preschoolers. Discussion will center on your current practices, building in additional supports and planning for next steps. Site visits to support implementation can be included. Livebinder will be used to organize and share resources.

The book study will be in two groups...come to the first two sessions and receive one graduate credit from Concordia University. You will be reading *Seeing all Kids as Readers* and *ABC and Beyond*.

An additional graduate credit is available by attending all four sessions. The book you would be reading in the last two sessions is *Wiring the Brain for Reading*.

The cost for each graduate credit is \$137.50. If taking for two credits the total would be \$275.00. Credits will be available from Concordia University. Registry credit and CEUs are also available.
