Overview

“The children of our future will not need our traditional school system to obtain knowledge, so if our educational system is to continue to exist this will occur only if they have the ability to create relationships and guide the learning process.” (Ian Jukes)

The **Leading for the Future** program was established in the fall of 2009 for dynamic and innovative building leaders who were seeking a venue through which they could enhance their leadership knowledge, skills, and abilities; as well as, improve their capacity to create positive relationships and guide the learning process for today. Based on a survey conducted at the end of this initial five session leadership development program, the **Leading for the Future** program accomplished its objectives and more. More than 90% of the participants indicated that the **Leading for the Future** program fulfilled its purpose and their expectations around leadership development and that it enhanced their personal leadership capacity. Ninety percent of these building leaders also stated that they would recommend this program to their colleagues and that they looked forward to participating in this program in 2010-11.
