Workshop 1: Introduction to Universal Design for Learning

April 7, 2016

Participants will understand and experience the three key features of UDL: explicit goal setting, learner variability, and the three UDL principles (student engagement, multiple representations, and multiple modes of action).

Workshop 2: UDL Guidelines

May 2, 2016

We'll deepen our understanding of the three principles of UDL, variability in engagement, action & expression, and representation. We'll investigate the checkpoints pertaining to each principle. You will analyze your current practices through the lens of the UDL framework.

Workshop 3: Using the UDL Framework in Your Work

May 17, 2016

This practical workshop will provide guided discovery and work time to incorporate UDL principles in current curricula. Participants will learn a facilitated feedback process to critique each other's UDL lesson modifications. Expect collaborative work time filled with passion for reaching all learners!
