#### Why RBI?

- The RBI is a family-centered method for gathering information about daily routines and intervention priorities.
- RBI allows parents and teachers the opportunity to share information and take ownership for determining & prioritizing outcomes.
- RBI can be used to create functional IEPs, complete eligibility information, determine present level of functioning in the three child outcomes (Indicator 7), and build positive relationships with families.
- The RBI results in a functional intervention plan, increased child engagement in everyday routines, and improved behavior, social interactions, and learning.

Participants will learn how to conduct an RBI, observe an RBI in action, and learn how to use the information to connect with all aspects of their work.
