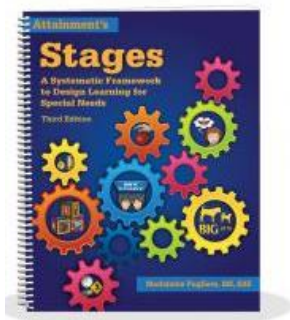

Question:

Answer:

Stages Framework is a guide to design learning and select educational materials for individuals with cognitive or language delays. The framework offers effective ways to: assess what your learners know; demonstrate their progress over time; choose from extensive lists of recommended appropriate skill-building learning materials; and describe learners using a common language with IEP and curriculum planning teams.

Included in the workshop:

- Overview of the framework, and demonstration of how to use the new Stages Observable Skills Checklist in the context of collecting evidence for alternate assessment.
- Hands-on learning with the nine dynamic apps. Emphasis on: GoWorksheet Maker, which quickly converts printed worksheets into customizable, interactive activities on an iPad and can be used across most Stages.
- Research surrounding differentiated instruction and universal design for learning that guided the development of the Stages Math Number Sense software and app.
- Skills practice and assessment activities are provided in nine key mathematical skill areas with options for learning scaffolds with customizable settings

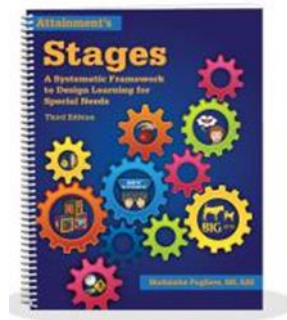
