- If you received your educator license after August 31, 2004 and are issued an Initial Educator License by the DPI for the first time in a particular category, then you need a PDP for license renewal!
- During this training, educators will learn using an electronic tool that prompts the development of a high-quality professional development plan to address self-identified learning needs based on professional reflection.
- This specific session is designed to provide educators support in working on the various components of their PDP that need to be completed at their stage in the process. That could include:
 - PDP goal development or
 - Finishing your PDP for final verification for license renewal.
