Requirements

We are looking for a good mix of 10-15 teachers at all grade levels who use Badgerlink resources. Selected teachers will need to complete training prior to the curation day. In order to receive a stipend for their time, selected teachers will need to accomplish the following tasks:

- Complete the training modules before curation day
- Bring 4-6 digital resources on curation day
- Curate at least 1-2 digital resources

Benefits of Curation

Selected teachers will receive:

- \$150 stipend for their time
- \$25 in travel expenses
- \$150 in sub. pay to the district
- 1 credit from Viterbo Univ. is available for \$200 (plus project/paper submission)
