

How to Be an Effective and Successful Teacher

Drs. Harry and Rosemary Wong are authors of the bestselling book in education worldwide, *The First Days of School*, with more than 3.9 million copies sold. Harry is the recipient of the Horace Mann Outstanding Educator Award and the only recipient of the Lifetime Achievement Recognition from the National Teachers Hall of Fame. Rosemary received the Distinguished Alumnus Award from the School of Education at Southeastern Louisiana University and Louisiana State University. Description

Effective means producing the expected and intended results, which for teachers would be student learning. Harry and Rosemary Wong will explain that the single greatest effect on student achievement is the effectiveness of the teacher. Effective teachers have a classroom that is structured and organized and **CONSISTENT** in how the classroom is run. They will show how effective teachers manage their classrooms for high-level student success, teach for lesson mastery so the students will learn and achieve, and have positive expectation for student success.

They will show many practical examples of:

- How to manage a classroom so that students do what they are supposed to do (thus, eliminating most behavior problems);
- How to teach for lesson mastery so the students will learn and achieve; and,
- How to produce students who will come to school each day with high expectations to succeed.
