Universal Design for Learning (UDL)

Description

Universal Design for Learning (UDL) provides educators with a structure to develop their instruction to meet the wide range of diversity among all learners. UDL is a research-based framework that suggests that a one-size-fits-all approach to curricula is not effective. Participants will learn about many aspects of UDL, including the principles, components, research basis for UDL, practical applications of UDL to lesson design, helpful technology tools that support flexible, inclusive instruction, and how it works with initiatives and structures already existing in schools (e.g., common core state standards, educator effectiveness, RtI, and PBIS).

Participants will learn some UDL principles to put into practice right away. At the second session, we will discuss the beginning trials of implementation and support additional implementation efforts.

Workshop Objectives

- A basic understanding of the history, purpose, and research behind UDL.
- Review and outline the UDL components including the principals, guidelines, and checkpoints.
- Discover and explore a variety of UDL resources to use and share with others.
- > Action plan next steps regarding UDL implementation.
