Federal RDA = Results Driven Accountability

Wisconsin RDA = Reading Drives Achievement: *Success through literacy*

- 4 areas:
 - Coordinated improvement planning with Title 1
 - Professional Learning Resources (co-teaching, UDL College/career ready IEPs, Literacy, promising practices for students with disabilities, mental health framework, MLSS, FBA/Bip toolkit, guidance for selecting interventions)
 - Coaching
 - Connecting compliance with results (Procedural Compliance Self-Assessment)
- CCR IEPs represent a shift from compliance to student outcomes
- How will DPI measure RDA?
 - 3-year analysis of student growth grades 3-8 (state test)
 - Changes in adult behavior/improving practice
