

# Pupil Nondiscrimination Workshop



CESA 5 is inviting district teams to attend 2 full-day workshops for assistance in completing state PI 9.06 Pupil Nondiscrimination Self-Evaluation and reporting requirements.

***PI 9.06, Wis. Admin. Code requires that every school district evaluate and prepare a written report on the status of nondiscrimination and equality of educational opportunity in the school district (the School District Self-Evaluation of the Status of Pupil Nondiscrimination and Equality of Educational Opportunities) at least once every five years.***

### **Required data elements include:**

- methods, practices, curriculum, and materials used in ... counseling..." (PI 9.06(1)(c), Wis. Admin. Code),
- "[t]rends and patterns in awarding scholarships and other forms of recognition and achievement provided or administered by the school district" (PI 9.06(1)(f), Wis. Admin. Code), and
- "[p]articipation trends and patterns and school district support of athletic, extracurricular and recreational activities" (PI 9.06(1)(e), Wis. Admin. Code).

**Who should attend:** District teams will vary based on district size and personnel duties. Suggested personnel includes: Athletic Director, School Counselor, Counseling Secretary, Principals and/or Director of Pupil Services. Teams may bring up to three members.

~Workshops will be capped at 35 participants on a first come, first served basis.~
