Your **Google Apps Admin console** is where you add users to your account, turn on the services you want them to use, grant people administrator access, and otherwise manage Google Apps services for your organization.

Google Apps Admin Console Advanced: 12:30 - 3:00 PM

The Google Apps Admin console is the central point for your routine tasks such as adding users, groups, managing applications and more. But what about the hidden administration features that you might not know about? Learn the advanced features available to you for Chromebook management, organizational unit security best practices and other hidden features to assist you with your Google Apps implementation.
