Rtl systematically organizes the way you operate your schools in order to reach the vision of academic and behavioral success for all students.

Objectives

- Provides a foundational overview of the Wisconsin Rtl Framework
- Opportunity for participants to consider the reasons to embrace and readiness to implement a Rtl framework
- Activities to support selection & actions of a leadership team
- Complete the Wisconsin School-wide Rtl System Evaluation to provide baseline evidence of current Rtl practices in implementation.
- Integrate or “braid” the identified Rtl priority into current building level goals and improvement plans.

Audience

School- and building-level Rtl leadership teams. Teams should be made up of a cross section of the staff, 4-7 people, with a principal as the recommended leader. Parent representation on the team is recommended.

Preparation

- Teams should bring school-level achievement data and current building level goals. Training activities will be grounded in these materials.
- Each school team will also need to bring a laptop with wireless internet access.
