Where other assessment and benchmark systems leave you wondering "Now what?" Fountas and Pinnell provide a link from assessment to instruction via classroom practices such as guided reading and read-aloud. Their professional book *The Continuum of Literacy Learning: A Guide to Teaching* is included with the Fountas & Pinnell Benchmark Assessment System and provides the basis for this workshop.

Drawing from this important resource, the workshop provides how *The Continuum* can be used to set goals for learning in planning lessons for individuals, small groups, and the whole class. You will create a reading and writing unit of study. A basis for the three workshop model will be discussed, and how to use *The Continuum* to create them.
