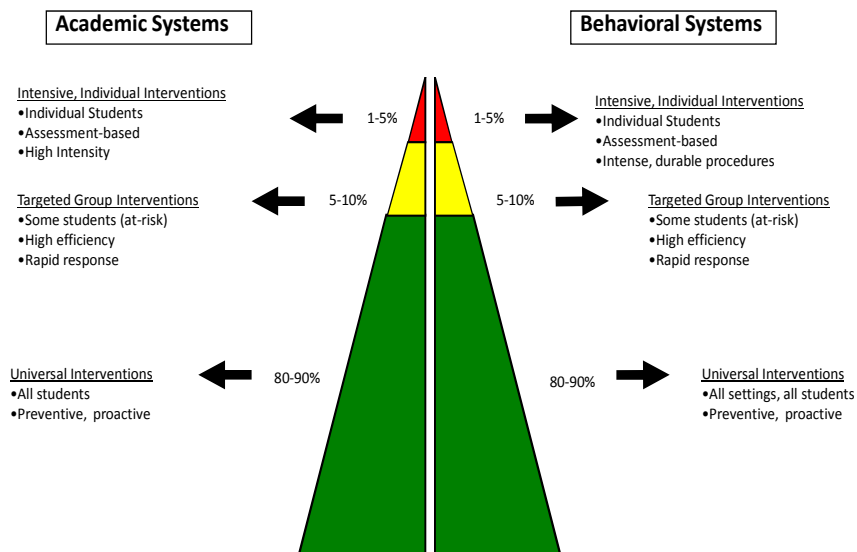

Designing School-Wide Systems for Student Success



This half day overview is for District Leadership Teams interested in the necessary commitments for implementing Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS). The overview will include a description of the rationale for implementation, the PBIS framework, an explanation of the step-by-step implementation of all 3 tiers of PBIS, and the steps for getting PBIS started in a district. PBIS is a proactive systems approach for creating and maintaining safe and effective learning environments in schools by ensuring all students have the social-emotional skills needed for success in school and beyond.
