

PBIS Administrative/Leadership Overview Tier 2/Tier 3

This full day training provides an administrative overview of the system structures and commitments needed for effective implementation of Tier 2/3 of school-wide PBIS, including a description of the Tier 2/3 practices, data tools and fidelity measures. Emphasis is on the continuum of support across a 3-tiered system, highlighting data tools and behavioral interventions for groups of students and individuals who require more than universal interventions to succeed.

District and school-level leaders need to have a complete understanding of what the PBIS Tier 2 and Tier 3 systems, data and practices entail so they can provide the necessary guidance to school staff as they move through Tier 2 and Tier 3 training and implementation. Repositioning of personnel to coach and facilitate specific PBIS Tier 2 and Tier 3 components become necessary at these levels. Administrators must be aware of needed roles/functions for Tier 2/3 implementation so they can anticipate and plan accordingly.
