- Brainstorm and record how Web 2.0 tools can be used in supporting classroom practice and developing teacher networks
- Create an avatar for use on education networks and become familiar with classroom uses for avatars
- Create and establish a wiki using PBWorks or Wikispaces
- Create and begin a Twitter micro-blogging account and establish connections with other educators during the course of the workshop
