

Reviewing Universal Reading Instruction Training Agenda

Outcome: School teams will learn how to refine their school-wide implementation of strong universal reading instruction.

Day 1

- Learn the key features of Wisconsin's Framework for Equitable Multi-Level Systems of Supports
- Define Comprehensive Literacy
- Address the need: state and local data
- Address the how: establish foundational beliefs, organizational trust, vision, commitment and ownership with a focus on cultural competence
- Investigate an instructional framework: Gradual Release of Responsibility
- **Determine the what:** systemic thinking and systematic practices

Day 2

- **Elementary Level:** Review and outline systemic evidence-based practices for phonics, fluency, vocabulary, comprehension and text complexity
- **Secondary Level:** Review and outline systemic evidence-based practices for comprehension, vocabulary, text complexity and critical points

Day 3

- Strategic Use of Data: Explore a systemic process for analyzing universal screening data
- Investigate and outline the universal classroom environment: instructional time and grouping, culturally responsive literacy practices, universal classroom procedure and routines, organizing physical space, and systemic literacy rich classroom environments.
- Analyze outlines and data, action plan and communicate next steps
