Overview

The Nonviolent Crisis Intervention[®] Training Program is a holistic behavior management system based on the philosophy of providing the best Care, Welfare, Safety, and SecurityTM for staff and those in their care, even during the most violent moments. The program focuses on preventing disruptive behavior by communicating with individuals respectfully and with concern for their well-being. The program teaches physical interventions only as a last resort – when an individual presents an imminent danger to self or others – and all physical interventions taught are designed to be non-harmful, noninvasive, and to maintain the individual's dignity. Follow-up debriefing strategies are also key components of the training program.

This is a full training for those that would like to obtain CPI certification or is in need of refresher training. We will go through the full curriculum to learn how to de-escalate students in crisis utilizing verbal and non-verbal techniques or non-violent physical interventions/restraining techniques.
