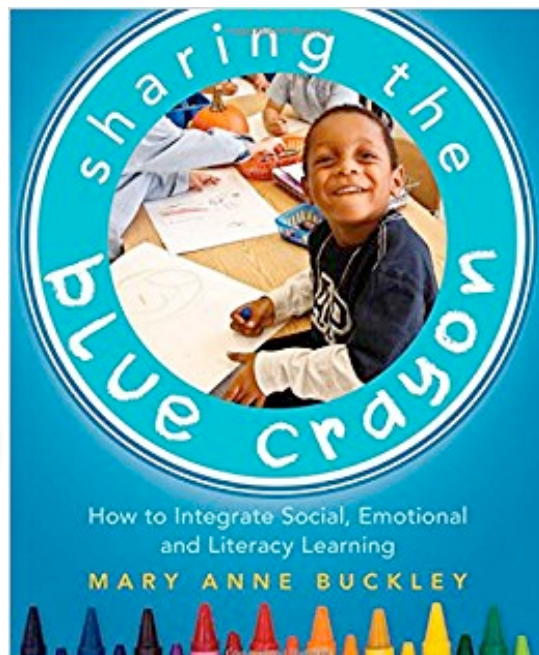


Sharing the Blue Crayon – How to Integrate Social, Emotional and Literacy Learning Book Study

This professional development opportunity is a book study that will expand the participant's thoughts around how to integrate **social, emotional and literacy** learning within the classroom. All participation is done via a blog that has been set up. Participants will read the assigned chapters for the week, visit the blog page and contribute to the discussion by posting (at least 2 times during the 7 week period).

Social emotional learning is at the heart of good teaching, but as standards and testing requirements consume classroom time and divert teachers' focus, these critical skills often get side lined. In *Sharing the Blue Crayon*, Mary Ann Buckley shows teachers how to incorporate social and emotional learning into a busy day and then extend these skills to literacy lessons for young children. Through simple activities such as read-alouds, sing-alongs, murals, and performances, students learn how to get along in a group, empathize with others, develop self-control, and give/receive feedback, all while becoming confident readers and writers.
