Nothing correlates higher to reading achievement than reading volume. We need to curate our classroom libraries to ensure that all kids have access to a wide range of compelling texts. We need to book match relentlessly. We need to provide expert research-based literacy instruction. We need to teach comprehension strategies explicitly. And we need to build in plenty of time for kids to *just plain read*.
