In response to requests from our CESA 2 districts, we are offering a session on Behavior Interventions. This session will focus on techniques that can be applied within an RtI or MTSS, PBIS, or EMLSS model. The techniques can be implemented with an individual, small group, or class/teacher level as well but, as with any technique, the impacts will be magnified by systemic use.

CESA 2 is partnering with UW-Madison's School Psychology Doctoral students to deliver the content. Broad categories of the behavioral techniques covered include: antecedent strategies, teaching expected behaviors, consequence strategies, and progress-monitoring.

Participants will receive the training, resources, and materials required to use the intervention strategies learned in the session.
