## R+ Early Language Curriculum (ELC)

**Monday, August 6, 2018 - 9:00 AM -2:30**

The Remediation Plus Early Language Teacher curriculum supports teachers with emergent literacy instruction. If you teach kindergarten or grade 1, buy the curriculum and learn how to teach the students the 26 letters, their sounds, how the sounds are shaped for the writing process and teach the students how to blend the sounds to learn how to read and segment them to learn how to spell. This curriculum is intended to supplement your existing literacy curriculum. The curriculum is also used for intervention students whose skills are too low for the Remediation Plus System of intervention. Interventionists take students through all or parts of this curriculum to prepare students for the core intervention program. Several CESA 8 early literacy teachers are successfully using this program with K-1 students at the universal, selective, and intensive levels.

The Remediation Plus System is a research based, clinically developed comprehensive curriculum (multisensory explicit systematic synthetic phonics) for reading and spelling. The R+ System teaches the 44 speech sounds in a systematic curriculum. Every lesson has direct instruction in hearing the phoneme, developing the phoneme grapheme correspondence and segmenting the phonemes from speech. This system includes 85 sequential lesson plans - everything a teacher needs to become a powerful remediator-interventionist and a profoundly knowledgeable reading teacher.

This optional follow up session will explore the role of automaticity in word recognition and fluency in reading connected text as a bridge to comprehension. Participants will explore strategies to enhance the materials in R+ system to build fluency and comprehension.

## Advanced Phonics & Decoding: Skills for Teaching in the Advanced Lessons

**Friday, January 11, 2019 9:00 AM-2:30 PM**

The optional follow up session will address the key concepts and skills taught in the advanced binders of the R+ curriculum. As students finish with the first 25 lessons of the intervention program and move into the advanced binder, they will learn to read and spell multisyllabic words. Participants will learn the R+ System approach to teaching the six syllable types and a flexible strategy for decoding multisyllabic words, review the doubling rules for short and long words.
