## Course 1: Reading Intervention for Struggling Readers, Monday, July 30, 2018 Grades 3-8

9:00 AM – 2:30 PM

This is an introductory session and is intended for participants who have had no prior training in Direct Instruction programs. Participants will learn a variety of strategies for teaching decoding, fluency and comprehension through the Direct Instruction methodology and will leave with knowledge and skills to implement specific programs targeted for their students' needs.

## Course 2: Multisyllabic Word Reading for Struggling Readers, Grades 4 and Above

Wednesday, August 1, 2018

9:00 AM – 2:30 PM

This session is a great follow up to Reading Intervention for Struggling Readers Grades 3-8 (Course 1), although it is not a required prerequisite. Participants will learn a flexible decoding strategy for teaching multisyllabic words. Students need to internalize this strategy in order to read grade level text with accuracy and understanding. Participants will learn the direct instruction methodology and will leave with knowledge and skills to implement specific programs targeted for their student's needs.

## Course 3: Reading Intervention for Struggling Readers, Grades 6-8

Friday, August 3, 2018

9:00AM – 11:30 PM

It is recommended, but not required, that participants attend Reading Intervention for Struggling Readers Grades 3-8 (Course 1) before attending this session. Participants will learn a variety of strategies for teaching **advanced** decoding, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension through the Direct Instruction methodology and programming and will leave with knowledge and skills to implement specific programs targeted for their students' needs. This session is best suited for students in grades 6-8 who are reading at or above the 4th grade level. They struggle with multisyllabic decoding, mild fluency issues, and mixed comprehension issues.

**Cost:** \$65 for CESA 8 – CIA Members School Districts, \$125 for all others (Lunch is on your own for ½ day workshops)

## Course 4: Intensive Intervention for Struggling Readers, Grades 4-8

Friday, August 3, 2018

12:00 PM – 2:30 PM

This session meets the needs of students in grades 4-8 who are reading at the non-reader through 2nd grade level. Direct Instruction methodologies and programming will provide you with the knowledge and skills to implement specific programs targeted for older students with severe decoding and comprehension issues.
