DESCRIPTION

Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) is small group, supplemental literacy intervention for students in grades K-12, who have difficulty with reading and writing. The Red, Gold, Purple and Teal Systems are designed for the lowest achieving students in **grades 3 through 12**, who are in need of a comprehensive, intensive literacy intervention. Lessons utilize engaging texts and are systematically designed to address comprehension, fluency, word study and writing about reading. The goal of LLI is to accelerate reading development and bring students to grade level.

Day 2, Nov. 8 – Running Records without Running Crazy // Let's have a Comprehension Conversation!
