

# Initial Educator Workshop

These sessions are designed to deepen understanding of content and instructional practices through active participation in effective professional development related to the professional Wisconsin Educator Standards. Each session engages the learner by modeling strategies, exploring classroom application techniques, and addressing student needs.
