

Training Description:

Participants will learn how to use an evidence-based and flexible Brief Intervention (BI) method to help students address a variety of behavioral concerns, including alcohol/drug involvement. Within PBIS, BI is considered a Tier II or Tier III strategy.

The first session will provide the nuts and bolts of BI as well as experiential skill building in the method. Following this session, participants are expected to try out BI, tape record a 20 minute BI session, and submit the tape to the trainer for review. In the second session, tapes with individualized feedback will be returned to each participant and skill building will continue.
