



# RtI Foundational Overview Training

A one-day-fast paced overview of the WI RtI Network

Rtl systematically organizes the way you operate your schools in order to reach the vision of academic and behavioral success for all students. This is not a technical "how to" training but rather a session to ground or re-align your current efforts with the Wisconsin Rtl Network.

## **Objectives**

During this session, school-level leadership teams will experience:

- Rationale to embrace and school readiness to implement the Wisconsin Rtl (W-Rtl) Framework
- Take away activities to support staff buy-in, understanding, and implementation of the W-Rtl Framework
- A completed baseline assessment using the Wisconsin Rtl School-wide Implementation Review
- A determination of a narrowed priority to aid in action planning

#### **Audience**

School and building-level Rtl leadership teams, seeking to build common ground around the Wisconsin vision for Rtl, made up of a cross section of staff, (4-7 people), with a principal as the recommended leader. Parental representation is also recommended. Teams will be working collaboratively around building-specific topics, issues, and needs.
