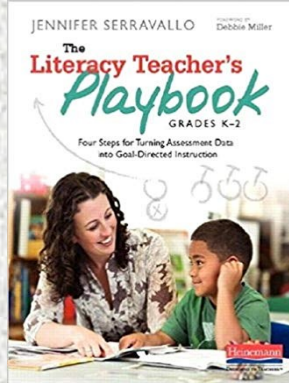
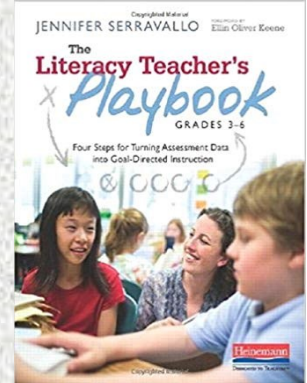


# CESA 9 Book Study: The Literacy Teacher's Playbook Using Assessments to Strategically Plan Instruction
