**Audience:** Building level teams who participated in the two day universal training.  
**Presenter:** Gary Mulry has 31 years in education and is currently in his third year as the Positive Behavior Support Specialist for Appleton overseeing the PBIS effort. He is also one of their PBIS External Coaches for 20 schools and 6 charter schools, as well as, providing EBD program support for the elementary and middle school level programs, and teaches graduate classes. Gary is also a Wisconsin PBIS Trainer.

**Description:** Participants will revisit essential school-wide systems (data, teaching, acknowledgement, and interventions) and use the *Team Implementation Checklist* to self-assess current implementation and action plans around identified needs. In addition, participants will look at the Benchmarks of Quality to begin to understand the use of the tool in self-evaluation.

Teams will Network and share successes, initial data, and ideas from their individual kick-offs. Team work will be provided for teams to work on specific areas they choose with support, resources, and guidance from PBIS trainer and CESA 6 staff.

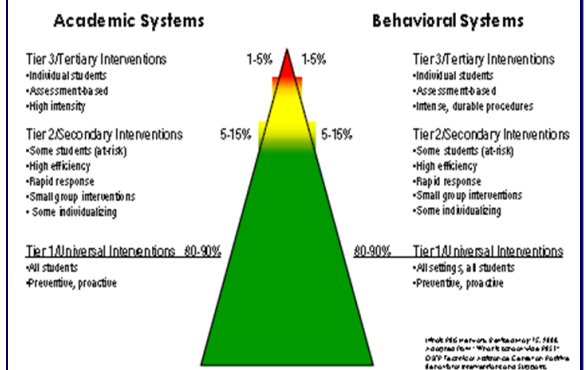
**Objectives:**
