DESCRIPTION

This is an introductory workshop designed to help you think through poetry in grades 3 – 8. You will explore the phases of poetry workshop and the integration of reading, writing, and student – led discussion along the way. You will be immersed in experiences and will begin to create your poetry anthology.

OBJECTIVES

Participants will:

- Understand the structure of a poetry workshop.
- Experience the four phases of poetry workshop.
- Create and start your own poetry anthology.
- Consider two rationales: a poetry unit of study and including poetry workshop on a weekly basis.
