Content Boot Camp

- **Day 1:** Engaging Readers in Nonfiction Text (based on Reading Nonfiction Notice & Note Stances, Signposts, and Strategies) *(Bring a fully charged electronic device)*
 - Choose complex, engaging text
 - Create text sets for increased rigor and depth of content knowledge
 - Apply close reading strategies to deepen comprehension
 - Get your students to initiate collaborative conversations about the text!
- **Day 2:** Engaging Students in Reading Textbooks
 - Learn a “non-freaked out” approach to content literacy and academic standards
 - Implement a process for unlocking meaning in text with before, during, and after instructional moves
 - Explore tools for effective note taking
 - Practice visual literacy skills
