Overview

The Nonviolent Crisis Intervention® Training Program is a holistic behavior management system based on the philosophy of providing the best Care, Welfare, Safety, and Security™ for staff and those in their care, even during the most violent moments. The program focuses on preventing disruptive behavior by communicating with individuals respectfully and with concern for their well-being. The program teaches physical interventions only as a last resort – when an individual presents an imminent danger to self or others – and all physical interventions taught are designed to be non-harmful, noninvasive, and to maintain the individual's dignity. Follow-up debriefing strategies are also key components of the training program.

This training will qualify as an Initial Training for those new to Crisis Prevention and also as a refresher for those who have had the training previously.

Initial certification participants will be required to complete an online training portion before attending the in-person training on February 14, 2019. Participants will also need to bring their completed homework from the online portion to the in person class, in order to receive full certification.
