SIR

The Wisconsin RtI Center's **School-wide Implementation Review (SIR)** is an excellent tool to use to annually monitor your school's progress when implementing a Culturally Responsive Multi-level System of Support for either mathematics or reading. The Wisconsin RtI Center staff developed the SIR to fulfill these primary purposes for schools working on RtI implementation:

1. What does RtI look like in action?
2. What does RtI look like in our school?
3. What are our RtI strengths?
4. Where have we improved?
5. What do we still need to work on?

The SIR is designed for school leadership teams, including the building principal and representatives of multiple perspectives, to complete together.

TFI

The School-wide PBIS Tiered Fidelity Inventory (TFI) measures fidelity at all three tiers of PBIS, and each tier is measured independently. It can be used as a progress monitoring tool and as an annual assessment tool.

The TFI is designed to help schools more systematically plan their implementation efforts for more effective PBIS implementation. After completing the TFI, schools can action plan around the results. They can leverage their strengths and consider improving the aspects of implementation that will have the biggest impact for the lowest cost of resources (i.e., time, money).
