- 1. How to use SWIS
- 2. How to train others to use SWIS
- 3. How to respond to the most common problems
- 4. How to help teams use SWIS information for effective decision-making
- 5. How to maintain SWIS use across normal school perturbations

SWIS Facilitator role is appropriate for you if you have formal time allocated in your workload to: implement SWIS with 2 or more schools in the next 12 months, work with those schools at least 5 times to assess readiness, train staff and build fluency in use of data for decision-making, and can integrate SWIS data with larger databases.
