SWIS Facilitator role is appropriate for you if you have formal time allocated in your workload to: implement SWIS with 2 or more schools in the next 12 months, work with those schools at least 5 times to assess readiness, train staff and build fluency in use of data for decision-making, and can integrate SWIS data with larger databases.
