Mentoring Conversations is an extension of Mentoring Essentials which provides mentors with the knowledge, skills and attitudes necessary to support beginning teacher growth through ongoing, formative, instructionally-focused feedback. It can be used as a facilitated training for new and practicing Teacher Mentors with the following outcomes.

Training outcomes are:

1. Explain the importance of trust in a mentor/beginning teacher relationship and within professional conversations
2. Assess competencies to identify personal strengths and areas for growth.
3. Review the Professional Conversations Protocol and consider its use in supporting beginning teacher growth and development
4. Determine appropriate supports for beginning teacher needs
5. Explore tools and resources for supporting beginning teachers within a cycle of continuous improvement

Mentoring Network Online Events: 3:30 PM - 4:30 PM

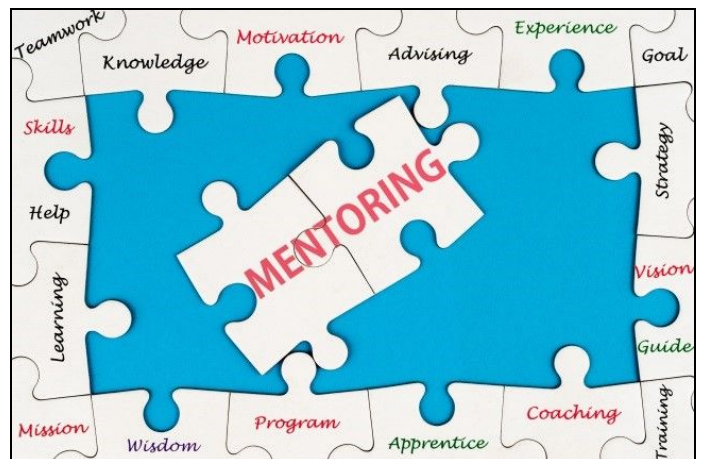
