The iPad continues to become more and more popular for supporting students with special needs. The touchscreen capabilities of the iPad—along with its predecessors the iPod Touch and iPhone—have stirred interest among developers to create applications to suit the needs of special education students.

The iPad changes the way teachers, administrators, and students access the web, share media, and learn on the go. The workshop will provide hands-on training on the use of the iPad, cover the initial setup of the iPad, how to add content to the iPad, how to make the most of iTunes U, how to find the best educational Apps available, and their uses in the classroom. An overview of mobile learning in the classroom, cutting-edge 1:1 programs, and volume licensing for education will also be covered. Leave the workshop with your iPad ready to go!

“There are so many different features developers can put into these applications,” says Eric Sailors, a speech-language pathologist at La Mesa Spring Valley (Calif.) School District. “It’s creating a multisensory product for children with autism and special needs. Kids who used to have difficulty using a mouse on a computer can use their fingers to touch and drag things and get immersed in the application.”
