

PBIS: Nuts & Bolts for Coaches/Administrators C100 Training

Audience: Building level teams including an administrator, external and internal coaches, teacher leaders from a variety of grade levels and subject areas, special educator(s), social worker, school psychologist, paraprofessional, and parent—ideally a group of 6-8 individuals from a building representing these groups.

Description: Coaches/Administrators: <u>Having attended a PBIS Overview session</u>*, this one day workshop is specifically designed for a building principal and the identified internal and external coach of school teams beginning the Tier I training of PBIS. This day focuses on preparing Coaches and Administrators for the various activities and steps their teams will take in moving to PBIS implementation. Those who attend this training <u>must return</u> with their school teams in order to complete the Tier I training process (2 additional days), Implementation in your School, and Becoming Swift at SWIS.

***Note:** Attendance at a <u>PBIS Overview session</u> is required prior to the start of Universal Team Training. This can be done by teams or by administrators. The Team Readiness Checklist must be completed and reviewed by Michelle Polzin, Wisconsin PBIS Center Coordinator, prior to training.

Presenter: Gary Mulry has 31 years in education and is currently in his third year as the Positive Behavior Support Specialist for Appleton overseeing the PBIS effort. He is also one of their PBIS External Coaches for 20 schools and 6 charter schools, as well as, providing EBD program support for the elementary and middle school level programs, and teaches graduate classes.
