**Training 1: Introduction to Mentoring Essentials\***

This training emphasizes the following basic principles:

- A period of induction is important for all new educators.
- A common vision is important to define effective educator practices.
- The professional relationship between the new educator and the mentor is critical to the success of the induction program.
- New educator's attitudes and professional practice are dynamic; effective mentors align their support to educator needs.
- Effective mentoring includes crucial conversations about improving professional practice.
- Mentors help provisional educators reflect and develop professional goals
