The iTouch & iPad are changing the way teachers and students access the web, share media, and learn on the go. These versatile learning and teaching tools can become a calculator, a drawing pad, an interactive map or a multi-language dictionary, all with a swipe of a finger. With access to thousands of apps for content areas, networking and collaboration, and creating; your students will be learning 21st century skills in an engaging format. Hands-on opportunities to explore new apps and create content for the device will be plentiful during the course.

In this course you will:

- Learn the basic functions of the iTouch/iPad.
- Discuss management of devices and purchasing of applications (apps) from iTunes Store.
- Explore and use various educational applications (apps) for the iTouch/iPad.
- Develop strategies to search and evaluate effectiveness of educational applications (apps).
- Create digital content to be placed on device.
- Explore applications (apps) that can be used to evaluate instruction.
- Create an activity/lesson plan that incorporates at least one app and digital content into the content area.

Participants should bring an iPod Touch/iPad and a laptop with iTunes software installed. You will need to have an iTunes account set up as well.

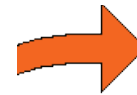
