## Classroom Management

### Rules, Routines, & Room Arrangement

Get ready for the upcoming school year. This workshop covers developing a classroom matrix, classroom routines, room arrangements, and active supervision. Everything you need to know to set a solid foundation for success this school year.

**Audience:** Classroom teachers, (especially new teachers and those that would like to refine their classroom management as part of their Educator Effectiveness professional development plan) instructional coaches, mentors, administrators, and pupil services personnel.

### Parent Communication, Open House, Conferences and Culture

**October 2, 2019 – CESA 8 or Virtually**

Dealing with parents can be intimidating in your first year of teaching, but there are several strategies that can help the communication go smoothly. In this session participants will discuss a variety of strategies to communicate student progress while engaging parents in the process.

### Classroom Management: Proximity Didn't Work; Now What? (Reality Check)

**Nov. 20, 2019 – CESA 8 or Virtually**

Now that participants have nearly a semester under their belt, it is the perfect time to re-examine how well behavior management plans are working and how to re-adjust course if necessary. Participants will have the opportunity to share behavior scenarios and brainstorm possible solutions.

### Assessment Strategies that Work

**January 29, 2020 – CESA 8 or Virtually**

Participants will discuss the benefits of timely, accurate, and frequent feedback. Together they will explore multiple ways to provide quality feedback in efficient ways. Additionally, the group will discuss how to use that data to inform instruction.

### License Renewal & Reflective Practices

**April 22, 2020 – CESA 8 or Virtually**

This session will explain the variety of options for maintaining, renewing and/or transitioning to a lifetime teaching license. It will also give participants the opportunity to reflect on their previous year in the classroom, especially in identifying practices to continue and those to change. Participants will create a mini-action plan to be mentally, physically, emotionally, and academically prepared for next year.
