## Training of Trainer Participant Requirements

- Participants should have prior experience in training adults and be knowledgeable in adult learning principles.
- Participants should have experience (3-5 years min) working directly with families.
- Participants should have the time available within their job responsibilities to prepare for and implement the training effectively following completion of the Training of Trainers.  
*(Note – Direct Staff Training is a total of approx 54 hrs = 9 days).*
- It's HIGHLY RECOMMENDED that the T participants previously participated in the Family Service Credential Direct Staff Training. Individual exceptions can be made depending on a participant's prior experience.

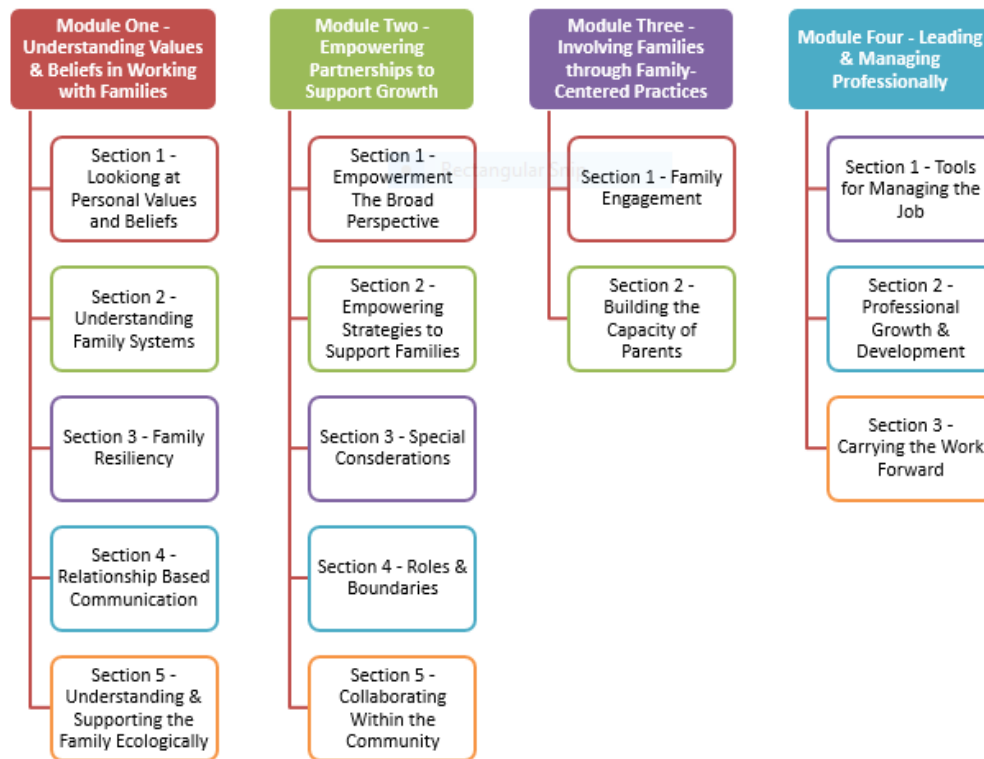
