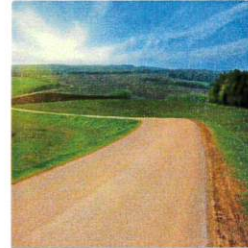


Boot Camp Series

Special Ed. Teachers

Join us at CESA 8, as together, we will spend 3 days during this school year on a journey down the road to see and experience what is involved in becoming a successful Special Education teacher.

This training is connected to being a new Special Ed. teacher (certified or non-certified) in years 1 or 2 of your special education teaching position. Agenda's for each of the three days will be sent prior to each session with specifics and details of the day.



The focus of the Boot Camp series will be on understanding caseloads - case management, prepping for IEP meetings, schedules, running meetings, designing CCR IEPs, supporting students across their day, communicating with family/staff/students, documentation, confidentiality, behavior, etc. over three days throughout the year. Topics may be adjusted based upon needs of the group. Input will be gathered after session one.
